## SITE VISITS & OTHER ENFORCEMENT ISSUES

- Law Enforcement Players: ICE, FBI, DOL, Campus Police
- Increase in complexity and number of H-1B site visits

 Institutional co-ordination of response to visit is crucial

- Comprehensive Immigration Reform (CIR) (stalled/pending)
  - House Democrats released a new plan yesterday
  - Consensus in D.C.—CIR must pass this year otherwise no action until 2015
- DACA (DREAM PROGRAM) Deferred
   Action for Childhood Arrivals (in effect)
- Fall of DOMA
- New Form I-9 and updated Handbook

# BACKLOGS IN PERMANENT RESIDENT QUOTAS

- Department of State <u>Visa Bulletin</u>
- Immigration Act contains strict quota for each employment based immigration category
- Quota of immigrant visas is further divided by nationality
- Backlogs continue for India and China

#### H-1B QUOTA EXEMPTIONS FOR BUSINESSES 'AT' YOUR CAMPUSES

- Colleges & universities are exempt from the annual H-1B cap
- FY 2014 H-1B cap hit in first week
- Recently graduated foreign students face uncertain sponsorship prospects
- Businesses 'at' your campuses may also benefit from your exemption at their own expense.
- The business petitions & must show the H-1B's duties are directly and predominately related to, and in furtherance of, the normal, primary or essential purpose, mission, objectives or function of the qualifying institution
